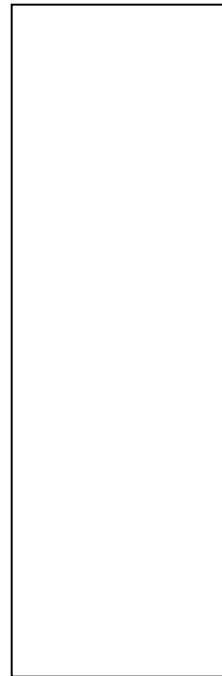

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS

We will be at the Thode Cabin/Gillespie Flat area this year. From Hwy. 260 go North on FR 117. Look for FR 117 at the bottom of the hill about 3 mi. East of the Sunrise turnoff – look for the Railroad Grade Trail sign and the turnoff to FR 117 is not too much farther on. On FR 117 go about 4 mi. and then left onto FR 61, which goes past Green's Peak. Stay on FR 61 until you cross a cattle guard and go past a little corral on the left side of the road and a cabin a little past that on the right (hard to see). The camp turnoff is about a mile from the cattle guard and through a short stretch of woods. The grounds may be soft from summer rains so be careful when you park your rigs. None of the roads are paved past Hwy. 260. We will put up signs at FR 117 and FR 61 but they may not be up until Wednesday or Thursday.

LODGING

The closest lodging is at the Sunrise Lodge. Early reservations suggested. Otherwise, lodging is available at Springerville, some at Greer, and Pinetop-Lakeside. Reed's Motel and Best Western in Springerville/Eagar or Greer Mountain Resort are 3 to try.

CAMPING

Camping permitted on the grounds. Porta-potties will be available. We will be on Forest Service land and we are REQUIRED to haul out all our trash, close gates as necessary, and possibly move horse stake-outs to minimize impact on the grounds. Before leaving, the Forest Service requests that you clean up your campsite by filling in dog holes, cleaning up or burying dog droppings, raking out horse stake-out areas, etc.

FOOD AND WATER

There is no water available on the grounds, so please bring your own water for yourselves, dogs, and horses. Some services available in the area are:

Hon-Dah Resort: water, showers, propane, RV dump
Hoyer Campground in Greer – water, showers, RV dump
Bear Paw RV Park in Eagar – water, RV dump

We will announce placements each day after the running for any stakes that are finished. We will have our cocktail party Saturday after running, time to be determined by the running, weather, etc.
